


## Traffic Management - Part Three



Now is the time for everyone to have their say on the proposals being put forward to improve traffic management in the village. A Public Meeting will take place on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> November at the Otford Village Memorial Hall at 2pm (traffic proposals on display from 1pm). This will mark the start of the consultation period which will run until midnight on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> December 2018.

**Time for action....!** A copy of the Traffic Management Questionnaire is enclosed and will only take a few minutes of your time to complete. This is an opportunity for you to have your say, your feedback is necessary to help us to improve traffic management and ensure our village is a safe place. You can return the questionnaire using one of our drop-off boxes around the village at Yvonne's, the Pharmacy, the Post Office, One Stop or the Parish Office. **More on travelling times at 20mph.....** We received some feedback on the numbers used in the article in last month's Parish newsletter on 20mph limits and journey times. The mathematical modelling used to calculate these numbers takes into the account the fact that it is nearly impossible to maintain an average speed of 30mph, the reality is that the average speed will be much less.
