Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Section 14(1), As Amended
By The Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

Kent County Council has made an Order the effect of which is to temporarily close Public Bridleway SR49A between Dynes Road and Tudor Drive from the 14 March 2022.

The path will be closed for a maximum of six months, although it is expected that it will reopen 2 May 2022.

The path is closed because works are planned on it.

The alternative route will be signed for the duration of the closure.

The public footpath between Otford and Kemsing (SR49a) will close temporarily between Dynes Road and Tudor Drive from the **14th March** and is expected to reopen on **2nd May**. The path is being closed for essential repairs to the Gas mains. Please note that the alternative route only has only a short diversion at the Kemsing end of the footpath and that the majority of the alternative route follows the existing path. It is unlikely that the works will take longer than advised and that KCC has posted a maximum of six months as a precaution. There will be maps showing the alternative route at the entrances to the path.
